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Coronaviruses (CoV) – CKLB Mauritius Update

According to official reports, the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) has been reported in only 12 countries on the African continent. As of the date of this news brief, no cases of the COVID-19 have been reported in Mauritius. Moreover, local authorities have taken a number of proactive measures such as travel bans (inbound and outbound) on a number of countries most affected, passengers undergoing health screening checks at the sea and airport and cases fulfilling established criteria by the authorities kept in quarantine or isolation at designated centres.

CKLB Team Response to COVID-19

The World Health Organisation officially declared the COVID-19 outbreak a pandemic on 11 March 2020. In the light of the COVID-19 outbreak, we have adjusted our policy to ensure that our services and responding capabilities remain unaffected as far as possible but preventing any risk of spreading the coronavirus in our workplace and community.

We are following closely the World Health Organisation and local authorities' recommendations and to this effect:
